

Proposed Nation-wide Lawsuit

Citizens for Safe Drinking Water, a group that is fighting fluoride on a national level, is raising funds for filing a lawsuit that is expected to benefit all of us initially on the west coast, including Washington State, and eventually the nation. Individual Plaintiffs will be asserting their Constitutional rights under the 9th and 14th amendments to be free of bodily intrusion, in this case protected against being forced to be medicated with hydrofluosilicic acid, an unapproved drug.

This legal assertion dates successfully back to the days of Cromwell and was recently quietly affirmed in what otherwise was a front page news item. Many of you may recall the news about military personnel being court-martialed for refusing to take an Anthrax vaccine.

Most newspapers throughout the nation did not report that the lawsuit, filed by military personnel who gave up their officer commissions for that specific purpose, succeeded against the powerful Department of Defense. Even with arguments of time of war, emergency, and specific tales of expected exposure to anthrax, the Court denied the DoD's ability to force the personnel to take the vaccine. DoD argued that the officers did not have standing to even file the suit, as the U.S. FDA was the appropriate enforcement agency and they had not acted to restrain the DoD's actions.

In what was a surprise to the DoD, but in accordance with settled law, the Washington DC Court ruled that the FDA does not establish what the FDA does or does not do -- that Congress determines what FDA shall and shall not do; and the Court issued an injunction on the basis that the DoD's order to compel the use of a vaccine that had not been approved for the manner in which it was administered is arbitrary and thus unconstitutional.

The decision to address the manner in which a drug is administered when considering the right to compel an individual without their consent is especially powerful in the case of hydrofluosilicic acid administered in water, as even though state courts have opined that the recipients of public water can just go get their own drinking water, the fluoridation process administers hydrofluosilicic acid trans-dermally as well.
